PROCLAMATION OF CONSTITUTION WEEK IN MILLCREEK**

**WHEREAS**, September 17, 2022, marks the two hundred and thirty-fifth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

**WHEREAS**, The Constitution, together with the Bill of Rights, have provided the organic structure for our Democratic Republic and our Individual Liberties, enabling our nation to rise from a collection of ragtag former colonies to a United Nation in which our people have created opportunity and built the greatest economy in the world, based upon freedom, creative genius and hard work; and

**WHEREAS**, our federal system has welcomed generations of immigrants from every part of the globe to participate in the freedom, opportunity and rule of law our Constitution affords, creating out of many groups, one indivisible nation; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a Proclamation each year designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Jeff Silvestrini by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the city of Millcreek, in the state of Utah do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as:

**CONSTITUTION WEEK**

**AND** ask our residents to affirm the ideals of the Constitution of the United States of America and the Bill of Rights by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed through this magnificent document, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
