Parley's Trail Opening is Just Around the Corner

MILLCREEK. If you drive on I-80 east of 13th East or if you live in the Canyon Rim area, you are aware of the large construction project taking place along the south side of I-80. If you're a non-motorized traveler (e.g., bike, stroller, wheelchair, feet), you are getting excited about the completion of that project. It won't be too much longer -- is October soon enough?

The construction completes the segment of the Parley's Trail between Tanner Park and Sugarhouse Park. Eventually, the Parley's Trail will connect the Bonneville Shoreline Trail at the mouth of Parley's Canyon to the Jordan River Parkway. With completion of this project, the trail will be improved from the Grandeur Peak trailhead parking lot all the way to State Street (saving only a short street ride in Sugarhouse). In general, the chair will allow an individual two minutes to address the Council. A spokesperson, recognized as representing a group in attendance, may be allowed up to five minutes. At the conclusion of the citizen comment time, the chair may direct staff to assist the citizen on the issue presented; direct the citizen to the proper administrative department(s); or take no action. This policy also applies to all public hearings. Citizens may also submit written requests (outlining their issue) for an item to be considered at a future council meeting. The chair may place the item on the agenda under citizen comments; direct staff to assist the citizen; direct the citizen to the proper administrative departments; or take no action.
