How Can Millcreek's Code Compliance Inspectors Help You?

MILLCREEK. Several of Millcreek's ordinances have been enacted to enhance your quality of life. For example, commercial businesses are required to store their garbage in covered containers that are emptied at least once a week. See Ord. [9.56.050](#). Property owners are not allowed to permit weeds to grow any higher than six inches. See Ord. [9.60.020](#). And nobody can store junk on their property. Ord. [9.60.010](#).

Millcreek currently has two Code Compliance Inspectors, and is hiring a third, to enforce these laws. You can contact them directly by calling or emailing them at:

Code Compliance Inspectors enforce city ordinances for the following:

- Litter and debris that can be seen from a street or right-of-way
- Inoperable and unregistered vehicles seen from the street or right-of-way
- Recreational vehicles parked on the grass or dirt in the front yard
- High grass and weeds over 6" tall
- City sidewalks that are blocked by garbage, building materials, merchandise, vehicles, or vegetation lower than 8 feet above a sidewalk
- Failure to remove hail, snow, or sleet more than 12 hours after the storm
- Trash receptacles left out more than 24 hours after trash day
- Conducting business without a city business license
- Operating a short-term rental without a business license
- Illegal or dilapidated signs
- Vehicles parked on lawns and not approved hard surfaces, such as asphalt or concrete
- Outside storage, such as refrigerators, washers and dryers, and household items
- Any illegal dumping of chemicals or waste in storm drains
- Lack of maintenance of live materials, such as lawn and shrubbery

Code Compliance Inspectors do not enforce ordinances for the following:*

- Abandoned vehicles parked in the street or right-of-way
- Stolen property
- Illegal activity
- Neighbor on neighbor disputes
- Vehicles parked on street during snow removal months
