NEW BIKE REPAIR STATION INSTALLED AT SUNNYVALE PARK

MILLCREEK. Eagle Scout Henry Jensen recently installed a bike repair station at Sunnyvale Park for his Eagle Scout project. Henry investigated where there might be a need and determined that the kids in the Sunnyvale area might not have access to bike repair tools and equipment. He worked with the City to determine placement within the park. He also raised the necessary funds to purchase and install it.

An air pump and tools to perform basic repairs and maintenance, like changing a tire or adjusting a derailleur, are securely attached.

A bike can be hung from the arms to allow the pedals and wheels to spin freely while making adjustments.

Henry will be recognized at Monday's City Council meeting for his work and contribution.

This policy also applies to all public hearings. Citizens may also submit written requests (outlining their issue) for an item to be considered at a future council meeting. The Chair may place the item on the agenda under citizen comments; direct staff to assist the citizen; direct the citizen to the proper administrative departments; or take no action.
