## **The Other Side Academy to Open Millcreek Thrift Boutique Across from City Hall**

MILLCREEK. The Other Side Academy will soon be opening a new thrift store just across the parking lot from City Hall at 13th East and 33rd South. A ribbon cutting ceremony for The Other Side Thrift Boutique will be held on February 10th at 3 pm.

The Other Side Academy is a non-profit organization that helps people who have struggled with addiction, homelessness, or criminal histories. Free of charge, the Academy provides them the opportunity to get their lives back. During the two-year program, participants learn integrity, accountability, and how to take pride in their work.

The Other Side Thrift Boutique will be operated by students in the Academy as

one of multiple vocational training schools, including a moving company, a construction team, and a culinary arts program. Because students operate these businesses, the Academy operates with no government funding. Every dollar earned in these businesses goes back into the Academy.

The Other Side Thrift Boutique will run completely off of donations. Manager Sierra Belka says, "What makes us different from other thrift stores is we'll pick up your donations; if it's something we can re-sell, we'll pick it up for free. And as a bonus, you get a tax write-off for all your donations."

Ms. Belka is herself a graduate of the Academy. "Before The Other Side Academy, I had been to multiple programs, but I still always went back to the same thing I was doing before and falling into the same habits. The Academy gave me all the skills I needed to succeed," she says.


## **WINTER ADVENTURES IN MILLCREEK CANYON**
