## SALT LAKE COUNTY SENIOR CENTERS TO REOPEN ON APRIL 19th

MILLCREEK. For our many residents who enjoy the classes and programs at the county Senior Centers, we have exciting news. On April 19th, Salt Lake County is reopening its Senior Centers county-wide. That includes Millcreek's own Millcreek Senior Center at 2266 E Evergreen Ave and Mt. Olympus Senior Center at 1635 E Murray/Holladay Road.

The COVID-19 infection rate has dropped dramatically in Salt Lake County since the first of the year. County-wide, the seven-day moving average hit almost 1,100 in early January, and is


## COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINIC HELD FOR MILLCREEK AND SOUTH SALT LAKE RESIDENTS

SOUTH SALT LAKE. The Salt Lake County Health Department, in coordination with Millcreek and South Salt Lake, held a COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic earlier this week at the Columbus Center.

The clinic brought the vaccination opportunity closer to residents who do not have the means to travel to one of the mass vaccination sites. Almost 200 residents in the area received their first shot and were scheduled for their second.

We were very pleased with the response, as the pandemic has seriously impacted many of our community members who live in the western portion of Millcreek. Due to the great response to the first clinic, we will be scheduling an additional clinic at the same location. Millcreek will continue to work to provide opportunities for our residents to get their shot.

ECONOMIC INCLUSION COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Salt Lake County is concerned that businesses from some disadvantaged communities in the valley will recover more slowly than others from the COVID-19 pandemic. It has launched the [Economic Inclusion Community Assistance Program](#), designed to connect helpful resources with businesses in communities where there have been long-term economic opportunity gaps.

To make these connections, the County wants to work with non-profit organizations that are already set up to help communities such as veterans, Black, Latinx, Native American, Asian-Pacific, and persons with disabilities. - 84106: 3,405 total cases (72 current cases)

- 84107: 4,185 total cases (60 current cases)
- 84109: 2,483 total cases (29 current cases)
- 84117: 2,549 total cases (47 current cases)
- 84123: 4,623 total cases (71 current cases)
- 84124: 2,165 total cases (32 current cases)

TOTAL: **19,410** (increase of 133 since 3/25/21, our last reported data).
