- 84106: 3557 total cases (13 current cases)
- 84107: 4409 total cases (32 current cases)
- 84109: 2576 total cases (13 current cases)
- 84117: 2668 total cases (19 current cases)
- 84123: 4872 total cases (30 current cases)
- 84124: 2250 total cases (9 current cases)

TOTAL: **20,332** (increase of 54 since 5/28/21, our last reported data).
