MILLCREEK. We are very fortunate to have a high-quality hospital, St. Mark's Hospital, right here in Millcreek. Founded by Bishop Rev. Daniel S. Tuttle of the Episcopal Diocese of Utah in 1872, St. Mark's was the first hospital in the Utah Territory. At that time, Salt Lake City was home to 12,000 residents, and growing fast.

The hospital initially was located in an adobe structure at 500 East and 400 South in Salt Lake City. It moved to its present location in Millcreek (1200 E 3900 S) in 1973. The additions over the years of the Cardiac Catheterization Labs, the Diabetes Treatment Center, an expanded Emergency Department, the Women's Pavilion and Labor and Delivery, and a Rehabilitation Center, continue to provide and expand state of the art treatment.

St. Mark's doctors, nurses and staff provide excellent care to those in need and remain committed to our community. A new patient tower is expected to open in 2023.

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## Volunteers Needed

MILLCREEK. The Millcreek Promise Program has partnered with the International Rescue Committee to provide resources and supplies to improve and rebuild the community garden boxes at the Millcreek Community Garden (3000 South 2700 East). All equipment is provided. A group of willing volunteers is needed to come and help make the action happen.

IRC staff and volunteers will meet at the Community Garden on April 21st and 22nd. Volunteers will start working on projects at 9 am both days, and will likely work 4-5 hours. Any donation of time, however, no matter how small, will be appreciated. Projects include:

- Construction of wire gabion boxes and filling the boxes with rocks
- Removal of debris to dumpster
- Site preparation/leveling with machine owned by IRC
- Construction and placement of 24 wooden boxes (24 ft x 4 ft)
- Filling boxes with topsoil and compost and placing weed stop on walkways between boxes
- Reinstalling drip irrigation


