

and Thom DeSirant cut the ribbon with the giant scissors and officially opened Millcreek Common and the Skate Loop last Saturday night during DJ Skate Night.


The Skating Loop was full of skaters ranging from experts dancing on wheels (and sometimes with partners) to stiff-legged beginners learning the ropes.



### **June 13: The Swinging Lights**



The supply is very limited - **First Come, First Served!**






