Community Council updates within Millcreek City Ordinances

Francis gave overview of changes:

Elections no longer required to be posted in newspaper of record, to reflect move to social media/online

Community Councils will be required to give formal response for planning and zoning recommendations.

Community councils will need to submit request for funds instead of receiving blanket \$3k appropriation. State law requires a study when public funds are spent. Study will take 2 weeks and must include benefit the city will reap with the proposed project.

MOCC has a \$7k cash balance. It can be spent under old rules without a study.

Updated Millcreek city subdivisions, landscaping, parking and mobility ordinances

Will get indepth discussion in Feb.

Landscape changes made so residents can get rebates by Jordan Valley Water conservancy district

Parking changes to have more electric charging stations and reduce parking ratio for affordable housing projects
