## Shuttered Millcreek School Reopens with New Mission

MILLCREEK. After sitting empty for several years, the halls of the old Millcreek Elementary School at 3761 S 1100 E are once again filled with eager children ready to learn.

The [Utah International Charter School](#), formerly housed in South Salt Lake, has moved to this new building which provides them with a larger facility to accommodate around 250 students from all around the world.

The Mission of the Utah International Charter School is to:

**"Give English learners full access to a rigorous secondary curriculum by providing [content-based, sheltered English instruction](#) in every class, and to empower refugees, immigrants and American-born students with collaboration skills, critical-thinking skills, and diverse global perspectives."**

Millcreek is home to refugee families from Africa and immigrants from Latin America, Afghanistan, Ukraine, South Sudan, Burundi and many other countries.

The children of these families face many obstacles adjusting to their new home and culture. The opportunity to master the English language at the school is an important part of that adjustment.

Millcreek welcomes these children and their families and are happy that the halls of the school are once again echoing with the sounds of happy children learning new skills.

## Millcreek Farmers Market


Join us at Millcreek Common every Wednesday from 5-8 PM through September for local produce, farm goods, artisan food, handmade crafts, and more!

The Millcreek Farmers Market has been approved to accept Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits at the Farmers Market, held on Wednesday evenings from 5 - 8 pm through September 25, and the Harvest Market, held on Friday evenings in October. We are thrilled to provide this service to promote access for low-income households in our community while supporting an additional revenue stream for local farms and food producers at the market.

In partnership with Utah's Produce Incentive Program, the Markets will also offer Double Up Food Bucks to further supplement SNAP benefits with fresh produce from local farms.

How to use the benefits:

- 1) Visit the Info Booth at the Farmers Market
- 2) Use the Horizon (SNAP) card to purchase market tokens good for all groceries sold at the market (bread, dips, produce, dairy, etc..)
- 3) Receive a two to one match of green tokens to be used for produce purchases at the Market.


## Fall Leaf Pickup

As the temperatures cool down and we head into fall, [Wasatch Front Waste & Recycling District](#) will begin the seasonal fall leaf pickup service.



**Starting October 16, residents can pick up leaf bags at the front counter on the second floor of City Hall (1330 E Chambers Ave.). Leaf bags are not collected from your curb.**

- Full leaf bags can be taken to area parks and placed in the District's trailers.
- Other yard or waste bags can be used for your leaves. Please do not dump garbage, yard waste, or other items at the leaf bag collection sites.
- Reminder: Leaves are not accepted in blue recycling cans.
- You are welcome to take leaf bags from any site for your own compost.

At the conclusion of the citizen comment time, the Chair may direct staff to

assist the citizen on the issue presented; direct the citizen to the proper administrative department(s); or take no action. This policy also applies to all public hearings. Citizens may also submit written requests (outlining their issue) for an item to be considered at a future council meeting. The Chair may place the item on the agenda under citizen comments; direct staff to assist the citizen; direct the citizen to the proper administrative departments; or take no action.
