

### MILLCREEK'S CLIMBING WALL REACHES MILESTONE

MILLCREEK. Only one month left to climb in this inaugural season!

When Millcreek's climbing wall opened in March of this year, Mayor Jeff Silvestrini and Milo the Millcreek Moose mascot showed how climbers of all skill levels could enjoy the challenge. Since their auspicious example, over 10,000 enthusiasts of all ages have now paid to climb city hall.

“The positive response has been overwhelming,” said City Councilmember Silvia Catten. “People love it. I’ve climbed it, my daughters have climbed it, it’s a huge hit!” she said. “There is something exhilarating about being so high up outdoors, with the wind and the views of the mountains.”

At 65-feet high, the wall is the tallest outdoor climbing wall in Utah. Funded by a \$200,000 Utah Outdoor Recreation grant, it also gives Millcreek the distinction of being the only city hall in the world that has a climbing wall on the outside.

From Momentum Climbing Gym to The Front Climbing Club, climbing culture is rich in Millcreek, a community whose motto is “Connected by Nature” and where easy canyon access is also a big plus. In fact, the world’s fastest speed climber, Sam Watson, is a Millcreek resident and was recently honored with a lifetime pass to the Millcreek Climbing Wall by the mayor and council in a city council meeting following his triumphant return from the Paris 2024 Summer Olympic Games.

But there is only one month left to climb the wall in this inaugural season, the city points out, as the wall will shut down for the winter November 16. Admission is \$7 and climbing shoe rental is \$5. The wall is open daily 11:00am - 8:00pm Sunday-Thursday, and 11:00am-9:00pm Fridays and Saturdays.

## District Diversion

As Utah’s population grows and consumer habits evolve, Wasatch Front Waste and Recycling is here to champion a greener future for our community. One way we measure our efforts is by our diversion rate.

**What are diversion rates?** Simply put, they measure how much waste we’re keeping out of landfills by recycling and composting.

We’re thrilled to share that our goal for 2024 is 18%, and we’re at an exciting 18.47%! This is a fantastic leap from 17.73% in 2023, and it’s all thanks to your efforts. By continuing to recycle and compost correctly, we can increase our diversion rates and decrease our contamination rates in efforts to ensure a sustainable future.



Below are the tonnages by program and diversion rate for your community:
