

the online survey. Survey participants were asked about their overall personal wellbeing and overall community wellbeing in Millcreek. These wellbeing indicators were both measured on a 5-point scale from poor (1) to excellent (5).

The **average personal wellbeing score in Millcreek was 4.23** with **83%** of respondents indicating their wellbeing at a 4 or 5 on the 5-point scale. The **average score for community wellbeing in Millcreek was 3.82** with **68%** of respondents indicating community wellbeing at a 4 or 5 on the 5-point scale. ZIP code 84124 had statistically higher overall personal and community wellbeing scores than ZIP code 84106.

(On a scale from 1=Poor to 5=Excellent)




### Comparing Wellbeing Across Utah Cities

The Utah League of Cities and Towns clusters cities and towns into five different categories based on size and growth rates. We utilize these clusters in our analysis. Millcreek is classified as a City of the 1st and 2nd Class. Some cities may fit within more than one cluster.

Within the more Urban city cluster, Millcreek was **well above** the average overall personal wellbeing score and **slightly above** the average overall community wellbeing score.

# Hear the **BEEP** where you **SLEEP**

## Every Bedroom Needs a Working Smoke Alarm!

Half of home fire deaths happen between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m., when most people are asleep.



Install smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside each separate sleeping area, and on every level of the home, including the basement. Larger homes may need more alarms.

For the best protection, install interconnected smoke alarms in your home. When one sounds, they all sound.



Test alarms at least once a month by pushing the test button.



Some people, especially children and older adults, may need help to wake up. Make sure someone will wake them if the smoke alarm sounds.



Replace all smoke alarms when they are 10 years old or if they do not sound when tested.



When the smoke alarm sounds, get outside and stay outside. Go to your outside meeting place.



Call the fire department from a cellphone or a neighbor's phone. Stay outside until the fire department says it's safe to go back inside.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE  
October 26, 2024**

The hardest part is over in terms of traffic impacts. The last of the blacktop went down on Thursday, with travel lane and directional painting/stripping ongoing. Traffic control impacts will still be noticeable when we resume next week, but these should be mostly rolling single-lane closures with far lighter traffic impacts through the construction route.

Our crews will be revisiting various property approaches to smooth out the transitions from concrete to the asphalt. Additionally, the painting and striping will require we bump traffic into open lanes, and occasionally intersections will be blocked to apply varied stop-bar and directional messaging. Bottom line? Orange construction barrels will be sprinkled throughout the construction zone, so stay alert and watch for our construction team members to provide instructions to motorists. We are beginning to shift into a colder weather pattern, so hang in there, stay warm, and keep an eye out for ongoing work through mid-November (see the full schedule below).
