Clawson has been instrumental in two of the largest volunteer efforts Millcreek undertook in the past couple of years—the building of a garden space for Millcreek elementary and the subsequent moving of that same garden space to a local daycare center. Clawson took the lead by designing the garden space, with garden boxes, awnings, and watering lines, as well as being on the ground with the volunteers for both the building and moving of the garden. Clawson’s willingness to serve his community is apparent in all his work, making him a deserving recipient of the award.

One amazing thing about Millcreek’s community is the number of young people who are so willing to volunteer and help. From a robust youth council to filling roles as interns in city departments, Millcreek youth have and continue to do great work. This year’s **Youth Volunteer of the Year award** was given to **ARIVAN VERMA**, who has served on the Millcreek Youth Council for several years and has worked as an intern for the Millcreek Promise Program.
