

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

SLC Public Utilities East-West Connection Waterline Project

(Approximately 3500 East along Metro Way to Grace Street at 3075 East)

MILLCREEK. The East-West Waterline Project being constructed by the Salt Lake City Department of Public Utilities (SLCDPU) will be closing Margie Avenue, between Metro Way and Grace Street, starting as early as Monday, January 6. Between Margie Avenue and Metropolitan Way, Grace Street will also be closed. These road closures are to accommodate for the waterline work. All travelers in the area will be detoured on Metropolitan Way and Valley Street. Crews anticipate to reopen mid-February 2025.
