MILLCREEK. For the past two years, Millcreek has been considering changes to the City's Zoning and Subdivision Codes to include better and clearer

standards for development in Millcreek. These changes have been compiled into a new Zoning and Subdivision Code. A copy of the draft code and summaries of the proposed changes can be found [on the city website HERE](#).

A series of public meetings have taken place over the past two years and the proposed changes have been reviewed by the four community councils.

Opportunities for input remain. There will be a public hearing at the **Millcreek Planning Commission** on Wed., 2/19/25, 5pm, City Hall, 6th Floor, 1330 E Chambers Ave.

After the Planning Commission makes their recommendation to the City Council, the council will also hold a public hearing. Watch the city council agendas in this newsletter for the date when it is announced.


