MILLCREEK. At the city council meeting on August 25th, officers from the Unified Police Department were each awarded a distinguished **Division Commander's Award** for their demonstration of outstanding bravery, teamwork, and selfless dedication while responding to multiple fires that threatened lives and property at the Willow Glen Apartment complex and surrounding neighborhoods.

Working alongside the Unified Fire Authority, they carried and moved fire hoses to aid suppression efforts, evacuated residents from burning and threatened buildings, and even entered smoke-filled structures to rescue trapped pets. Their quick actions also ensured displaced residents were relocated to safety, traffic was diverted to allow emergency access, and firefighters received critical information about potentially unaccounted-for residents.

When a second fire erupted nearby, the officers immediately responded, evacuating homes in the fire's path and directing suppression crews. Their intervention prevented loss of life and property damage, containing the fire before it spread further.

Through their courage, decisiveness, and commitment to public safety, these officers protected the community under dangerous and chaotic conditions. Their actions reflect the **highest standards of service and sacrifice**, bringing great credit to themselves, the Unified Police Department, and the citizens they serve.



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING:

The purpose of this notice is to advertise a **public hearing on Tuesday, September 16, at 6 p.m. MDT, at Millcreek City Hall (1330 East Chambers Avenue, Millcreek)**. This hearing is regarding proposed work to be performed along 3300 South from 2700 East to the west side of the I-215 interchange in Millcreek, Utah. The project includes a 1" mill and pavement overlay of the existing road pavement. Planned improvements include; Restriping of the project area to reduce 3300 South to two lanes and allow for a buffered bike lane, restoration of existing striping, replaced signs as identified by UDOT Region 2 Traffic & Safety, reconstruction of valve boxes and manholes, installation of new fiber lines in existing conduit, and the reconstruction of pedestrian ramps. Improvements are being proposed by the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) as a measure to improve safety and access management at the intersection.

*Notice of special accommodation during public meetings: Any individual needing special accommodations (including auxiliary communicative aids and services) during this meeting should contact the project email.*
