



ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE



Construction crews will begin the complete reconstruction of the Neffs Canyon parking lot on **Monday, September 15**, and will continue until early October 2025. During this time, the parking lot will be fully closed to facilitate the removal and replacement of the asphalt layer. However, the Neffs Canyon trailhead will remain open and accessible.

Please note that parking along White Way is prohibited, and violators will be ticketed. Residents in the area may notice an increase in parking on public roads. If you see any vehicles parked illegally, please get in touch with the non-emergency UPD line at 801-840-4000.


CONSTRUCTION NOTICE



Construction crews will begin work on Astro Way, extending towards Gilroy Road, as part of the storm drain construction project. The project is expected to **start as early as Monday, September 8**, and continue through the beginning of November 2025.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Construction activities will take place Mon – Fri (7 a.m. – 5 p.m.)
- Intermittent road closures and traffic shifts
- Third-party utility lines marked and flagged
- Temporary driveway closures and impacts to directly impacted residents
- Street parking along Gilroy and Astro will be restricted
- Increased noise, dust, and vibration
- Construction vehicles, equipment, and traffic cones in the area



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Millcreek plans to install a brand-new stormwater infrastructure along Astro Way toward Gilroy Road to improve the drainage system and mitigate flooding risks in the area. The project aims to strengthen and expand the existing storm drain system to handle heavy rainfall, helping Millcreek manage flooding concerns more effectively.

At the conclusion of the citizen comment time, the Chair may direct staff to assist the citizen on the issue presented; direct the citizen to the proper administrative department(s); or take no action. This policy also applies to all public hearings. Citizens may also submit written requests (outlining their issue) for an item to be considered at a future council meeting. The Chair may place the item on the agenda under citizen comments; direct staff to assist the citizen; direct the citizen to the proper administrative departments; or take no action.
