Another Successful Chipper Days Clean-Up

MILLCREEK. We thank the Unified Fire Authority for once again providing the popular Chipper Days in the Mount Olympus area of the city. This area of the city, nestled up against the forest is an urban interface designation and faces increased fire danger.

In 2020, a fire in Neffs Canyon ignited and with the right wind direction and speed could have moved into the Mt. Olympus neighbor, potentially damaging homes. The Forest Service and Unified Fire Authority moved swiftly to get the fire under control and no damage to man-made structures occurred. The 20-acre fire, however, was a wake-up call, reminding residents how easily a fire could move from the forest into the urban interface and then into residential neighborhoods.

The Unified Fire Authority, in coordination with the city and the Mt. Olympus Community Council, has for several years been providing Chipper Days to the community in order to reduce fire danger, assist residents in providing a safe space around their homes, and educating homeowners as to how they can help keep their homes safe.

Chipper Days comes around annually and is offered around Salt Lake County in urban interface, high fire danger areas, where residents are urged to clear brush from proximity to structures, stack it alongside the roadway with cut ends facing the street where UFA crews can chip and remove it.

Over the past week, crews have removed the highest quantity of brush in a Mt Olympus Chipper Days yet. Forest fires are happening more frequently all across the country and residents can help protect their homes by taking the proper measures. We appreciate the UFA crews who handled the chipping and the Mt. Olympus Community Council volunteers who distributed flyers and assisted residents in getting their property ready.

Learn How to Preserve Your Treasures



MILLCREEK. CHaRM stands for Collection of Hard to Recycle Materials. These pop-up events help residents repurpose and recycle materials that would otherwise be landfilled. The Utah Recycling Alliance (URA) is working in partnership with Millcreek to host a CHaRM event on October 11th, from 9am to noon. The URA team and volunteers will be available to collect a range of materials:

mattresses and box springs
oral care
outdoor equipment
scrap metal
socks
Styrofoam/EPS (expanded polystyrene)
tires and tubes
document shredding

#1 plastics, plastic bags and wrap
batteries
bikes and parts
carpet padding
cell phones and chargers
cords cables and string lights
electronic waste
ink and toner cartridges
light bulbs

Start now to clear out those tough to recycle items from your home or garage, and bring them down to City Hall on the morning of October 11th. Thanks to our team of expert processing partners, the URA can help keep these valuable materials in the circular economy and out of landfills
