#### **Notice of Vacancy and Appointment as Millcreek Mayor**

*Pursuant to Utah Code § 20A-1-510, Millcreek hereby gives notice of a vacancy of the Millcreek Mayor due to a midterm resignation. The remaining term will be from November 10, 2025 until the next mayor is sworn in (early January 2028) following the election in 2027.*

*Individuals interested in being considered for appointment must meet the qualifications for office and submit their application for consideration. Applicants must:*

- *Be a United States citizen.*
- *Be a registered voter of Millcreek.*
- *Be a resident of Millcreek for at least 12 consecutive months prior to the appointment date of November 10, 2025.*

*The application (can be found online, <https://www.millcreekut.gov/161/Elections> ) includes:*

- *Declaration of Candidacy Form*
- *Resume (not to exceed 2 pages)*
- *Letter of Intent Describing Why You Want to Be Mayor (not to exceed 1 page)*
- *Completed Questionnaire*
- *Conflict of Interest Form*
- *\$50 Filing Fee*

*All applications must be received in person by the Recorder's Office between September 30, 2025, and October 14, 2025, during regular business hours (8am-5pm) at Millcreek City Hall, 1330 E Chambers Avenue, Millcreek, UT 84106.*

*The Millcreek City Council will interview candidates and select the appointee during a public meeting to be held the evening of **Monday, November 3, 2025**, at a time yet to be determined at Millcreek City Hall, 1330 E Chambers Avenue, Millcreek, UT 84106.*

*Millcreek will fill the vacancy by administering the oath of office at a public meeting to be held **Monday, November 10, 2025, at 7:00 PM** at Millcreek City Hall, 1330 E Chambers Avenue, Millcreek, UT 84106.*


