Nicole Handy is New Councilwoman

MILLCREEK. Longtime Millcreek resident **Nicole Handy** has been sworn in as the new District 3 city councilwoman. She was appointed by the city council to fill the remaining two years in the term of now-Mayor **Cheri Jackson**, who resigned her council seat upon becoming mayor. Her appointment was confirmed during the November 24 city council meeting, where she took the oath of office and restored the council to its full five-member body.

“I am thrilled to be part of such an amazing council and excited to work with them on preparing Millcreek for a bright future,” Councilwoman Handy said. “There are so many outstanding residents in District 3, and I’m deeply humbled to be selected from the impressive talent pool of applicants,” she said. In a public interview process, Handy rose to the top of the nine-candidates, which included **Linda Zenger, Ian Wright, Amber Measom, Leslie Moss, Matthew Gardner, Michael Gura, Nathan Gibby, and Patti Hession.**



Councilwoman Handy brings extensive experience in community engagement, nonprofit leadership, and education. She and her husband Garrett - pictured here with Councilmember Handy and their daughter Jane Handy - have raised their four children in the Canyon Rim area.

During her interview, she emphasized that her service on the Board of Trustees of Canyon Rim Academy—particularly throughout the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic—helped prepare her to navigate complex and evolving community issues.

Handy began her career as a teacher, and her professional and volunteer experience expanded to include event coordination for the Utah League of Cities and Towns and Millcreek’s Venture Out! Festivals, as well as involvement in statewide initiatives such as Better Days 2020, Spike 150, Project Homeless Connect, and the Utah Association of Financial Services Foundation.

Handy currently serves as the executive director of **America250 Utah**, a statewide initiative commemorating the nation’s 250th anniversary. She holds an executive master’s in public administration from the University of Utah and a bachelor’s degree in English Education from Brigham Young University.

Mayor Jackson extended a warm welcome to the new councilmember, noting, “I have known Nicole for many years and look forward to working with her in this new capacity,” adding that “she will be a wonderful addition to the council.” As the new District 3 representative, Councilmember Handy will serve through the end of the current term, concluding with the next municipal election in 2027.
