Public Comment Period for New Gravel Mine in Parleys Canyon Ends on Saturday, January 31st, Get Your Comments in Now

MILLCREEK. The proposal to allow a new gravel mine on the south side of Parley's Canyon has been of concern to Millcreek, particularly in the Canyon Rim and northern Mt. Olympus neighborhoods for several years.

The Division of Air Quality (DAQ) has noticed their [Intent to Issue an Approval Order](#) (scroll down to ninth project) in response to an application by Granite Construction Company (GCC) to operate an aggregate mining facility at it's I-80 South Quarry in Parley's Canyon, near Millcreek. The facility will involve aggregate mining, as well as crushing and screening operations, during which


GCC will operate crushers, diesel generators, conveyors, a feeder, and a screening system.

The public comment period will end on January 31st, 2026. Written comments received by DAQ on or before that date will be considered in making the final decision on the approval/disapproval of the proposed project.

Written comments can be mailed to the Utah Division of Air Quality, 195 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84116, or emailed to jpersons@utah.gov. As detailed in the Intent to Approve Order, **written or emailed correspondence regarding this project must include the engineer's name, John Persons, as well as the DAQE number: DAQE-IN161200002-25.**

The city has submitted their comments, mostly related to the concern of the dust that is blown down the canyon into the Mt Olympus and Canyon Rim neighborhoods almost daily and comments of photos related to the dust problem would be very helpful. holding monthly meetings where all residents and interested parties can learn about building, zone change, conditional use, mixed-use, and all other applications that have been received.



2025 Adopted Utah Wildland-Urban Interface (WUI) Map

Millcreek Adopts the 2006 Utah Wildland-Urban Interface Code

MILLCREEK. Millcreek has adopted the 2006 Utah Wildland-Urban Interface (WUI) Code, effective January 1, 2026. This code will be administered within the designated Wildland-Urban Interface area of Olympus Cove (see map above or click [HERE](#) to view map on city website). The WUI Code requires that new construction within this area utilize fire-rated materials on exterior structural components. These enhanced construction standards are intended to improve the resilience of structures located in wildfire-prone areas.

On January 5, an open house was held at Churchill Junior High School to inform residents of the code adoption and to solicit public comment. Residents provided valuable feedback regarding both the code and the designated WUI area. Overall, comments were positive and supportive, with several residents noting that the code is a necessary measure to increase protection in areas susceptible to wildfires. Public feedback also indicated that the current map represents a reasonable and balanced approach to wildfire mitigation.

Millcreek City has conducted an additional review of House Bill 48, along with comments from the Unified Fire Authority, the State Division of Forestry, Fire & State Lands, and Millcreek residents. Based on this review, the City has determined that the currently adopted map satisfies all state requirements and represents a responsible step forward in protecting the community from wildfire risks.

As a reminder, the adopted map and its associated regulations do not impose any fees, require changes to existing homes or landscaping, or regulate insurance in any manner.

The City is also monitoring the current legislative session for any new bills or state requirements that may require us to amend the Wildland-Urban Interface Code or the associated map. The community will be notified should any changes be required.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Enbridge Gasline Construction Starting Soon

MILLCREEK. Enbridge Gas will be replacing sections of its natural gas system along the east side of Millcreek to enhance its services. Construction along Wasatch Boulevard is anticipated to begin in mid-February 2026* and continue throughout the year.

Millcreek will be hosting a **project open house** with Enbridge for residents to learn more about the project and what to expect during construction.

Location: Churchill Junior High (3450 E Oakview Dr, Millcreek, UT 84124) in the Lobby

The approximate locations of the construction are as follows:

- Wasatch Boulevard, from approximately 4500 South to Upland Drive
- 3300 South, from 2700 East to the I-215 entrance
- Sections of Virginia Way
- Sections of Millcreek Canyon Road
- Sections of Plaza Way
- Sections of Cummings Drive
- Sections of Terrace Drive


