We hope you all had wonderful July 4th and 24th celebrations!
This is a reminder that after tonight, discharging fireworks will no longer be allowed during this holiday season.

Please be aware of the law, and follow all the rules as outlined below by the Unified Fire Authority:

- Discharge dates: Day before, day of, and two days after July 4th and 24th
- Penalties: Persons guilty of an infraction if:
 - Discharge of fireworks outside of legal dates
 - Discharge of fireworks in an area where fireworks are prohibited
 - **UP TO \$1,000 FINE**


